### **MALAYSIA CROSS CULTURE TRIP**

The major attraction of the city were its towers, the marvellous Petronas Twin Towers, its skybridge and the KL Towers, standing out as symbols of the city's might. The war memorial, spoke of the history of Malaysia. The KL Gallery, the King's Palace, the Cocoa Boutique and the Handicrafts Centre gave an insight into the native culture of that country.

The last day was marked by a visit to the TARC University, one of the oldest and prestigious institutions of the country; where the students were welcomed to a cross cultural programme; which gave insights on the culture, history, traditions, cuisines and languages of Malaysia.
